FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I volunteer?

Fill out this application and return it to the checkout desk at the library. If you need to complete hours for a project, the circulation staff member will schedule your hours. If you are volunteering long-term, the Teen Volunteer Coordinator will review your application and contact you to schedule your hours.

How old do I have to be to volunteer?

You need to be between 12 and 18 years old to volunteer.

How many hours can I volunteer at one time?

Volunteers are usually scheduled to work 1-2 hours at a time. Longer shifts may be discussed and scheduled with the Teen Volunteer Coordinator.

What will I do when I volunteer?

Volunteers help us in a variety of ways including straightening shelves, cleaning books, preparing materials for programs, and assisting with programs.

If you are volunteering for community service or to work off fines, check with staff for eligibility.
