How do I volunteer?

Fill out this application and return it to the Circulation desk. The Teen Volunteer Coordinator will review your application and contact you to schedule your hours.

How old do I have to be to volunteer?

You need to be between 12 and 18 years old to volunteer.

How many hours can I volunteer at one time?

Volunteers are usually scheduled to work 1-2 hours at a time. Longer shifts may be discussed and scheduled with the Teen Volunteer Coordinator.

What will I do when I volunteer?

Volunteers help us in a variety of ways, including straightening shelves, cleaning books, preparing materials for programs, and assisting with programs.
